For the next eight meetings, we'll be using FCCI's Pathway to Purpose content as the basis for our discussions. Part One is "Building a Kingdom Focus," prepared by former FCCI CEO Kent Humphreys. Referencing John 17, to have a Kingdom focus:

- 1) Be inclusive within the larger Body of Christ .
- 2) Maintain an intimate personal relationship with Him.
- 3) Be willing to reveal Christ to others.
- 4) Trust that God will provide the opportunities and the resources. He has given us spheres of influence. For example, Jesus ministered to those that God gave to him. The Lord will give us the words, will protect, sanctify and send us to people and places so that He is glorified.
- 5) We have a responsibility for generational transfer of the Good News and what He has taught us.

Based on these key points:

—Who have you been needing to include in your personal ministry? How was this revealed to you?

—In what ways does your intimacy with Jesus need to be improved upon? How will this impact your workplace ministry?

—How are you revealing Christ wherever you are? At home? Out and about? At work?

—What opportunity has God recently provided so that you may be His minister in your daily life? What opportunity do you feel like you have recently missed?

—Who can you potentially see in your sphere of influence as part of your "twelve" (disciples)?

—What has been passed to you by previous generations? What things do you want to pass to others?
