- Today's Topic: How do you make decisions?

A wise man is strong, Yes, a man of knowledge increases strength; For by wise counsel you will wage your own war, and in a multitude of counselors there is safety. —Proverbs 24:5-6 (NKJV)

Operating for-profit or non-profit businesses requires a LOT of decision-making.

Some decisions require an instantaneous response. You don't have the "luxury" of taking the time to pray for an extended period, study Scripture and ask trusted, wise people for advice.

Sometimes we *think* we need to make an instantaneous decision due to external pressure, internal eagerness or impulsiveness, but in reality we do have time to make the decision.
