



- Today's Topic: **The Nuclear Fallout of Lust**

“...each person is tempted when they are dragged away by their own evil desire and enticed. Then, after desire has conceived, it gives birth to sin; and sin, when it is full-grown, gives birth to death.” (James 1:14-15)



“Nuclear” means pertaining to the nucleus or core.
“Fallout” means incidental result or side effect.

In today's secular culture, we rarely hear about “sin.” There are few moral absolutes, and freedom appears to be license to say and do whatever we feel like, whenever we feel like it.

Like fallout from the damaged nuclear power plants in Japan, the reality is that when our resistance to lust melts down, there are side effects from our core disobedience. These side effects can be like earthquakes or tsunamis in our lives and businesses—affecting us, employees, customers and suppliers.

What are some common lusts that business owners and employees can be dragged away with?

Can you think of examples of businesspeople who gave into their lust, and paid a price?

Have you ever struggled with lust? If so, how? Did you steer away, or were dragged in?
