- Today's topic: **The 3 R's of Leadership**



This winter, we're using FCCI's Pathway to Purpose content as the basis for our discussions. Today's topic is based on a message by Dick Wynn, former President of Youth for Christ and leadership consultant who is now home in Glory.

He identifies five common traits among "super" leaders:

**Vision - Communication - Persistence - Empowerment - Organizational ability**

Vision is necessary for effective leadership. People follow leaders, and resources follow vision. Vision without strategy and a plan for implementation is hallucination. Many leaders only hallucinate about having an effective strategy, measurements and results. They come off as visionaries but in reality they are only dreamers.

Leaders are strong in **Relationships - Results - Resilience**

They are interdependent within the Body, family, and circle of friends and colleagues. The challenges in relationships are one's capacity (1) model for, (2) mentor, (3) manage, and (4) minister to others.
